- 6. Identify one social issue presented in this song and explain why you feel this way
- 7. What is the narrator inviting/asking people to do?
- 8. What does the lyricist mean when they say "just beat it, doesn't matter who's wrong or right"?
- 9. If you could pick one social issue to use this as a public service announcement for what would it be and why?
- 10. Based on the lyrics and the video when was this song written?
- 11. Based on your answer above why do you think this song was written during that time period?
- 12. What is the songs theme?
- 13. Choose one section of this song and rewrite the lyrics using the song video
